Installation

Care and Maintenance

Stainless steel is a highly durable material but will require regular cleaning to maintain and protect the surface from defects.

- Clean stainless steel shower trays, sinks and benches after use with soapy water or a damp cloth.
- To prevent mineral deposits forming always wipe excess water from stainless steel with a clean cloth.
- If a stainless-steel cleaner/polish is used always apply with a nonabrasive cloth or sponge
- Wire wool and abrasive cleaners should be avoided as these can scratch the surface. Use only non-scratch cleaning pads.
- Do not use steel wool as it can leave minute particles of wire on the surface which can develop into rust marks.
- Cleaners containing chloride (bleach) are not recommended and if used, must be rinsed from the surface immediately to prevent corrosion.
- Do not store open containers of cleaners or chemicals such as acids, bleach, sodium chloride, toilet bowl cleaner, drain cleaner, household cleaners, or hard water stain removal products on or under stainless sinks, shower trays and benches as vapors may be corrosive.
- Most stainless-steel products will scratch from everyday use however these scratches will blend over time to create a unique finish.
